Positive Behavior Supports

We use The Teaching Family Model, an internationally recognized behaviorally-based program, to provide emotional and behavioral support to our students.

We collect data for each student throughout the day and across settings to identify the root cause of a student's ineffective behavior. The program relies on the principles of applied behavior analysis (ABA), and offers positive cognitive behavioral supports to ensure that each student learns new, more appropriate ways to solve problems.

Students also learn relaxation and stress control techniques. Our biofeedback/neurofeedback program uses sophisticated equipment and gamebased software to help students develop greater selfawareness and self-control.

Every moment in the school day is a chance to learn. A masters level certified school social worker is in each classroom to help support positive change and to capitalize on opportunities to learn new social skills and problem solving right then and there- not hours or days later.
